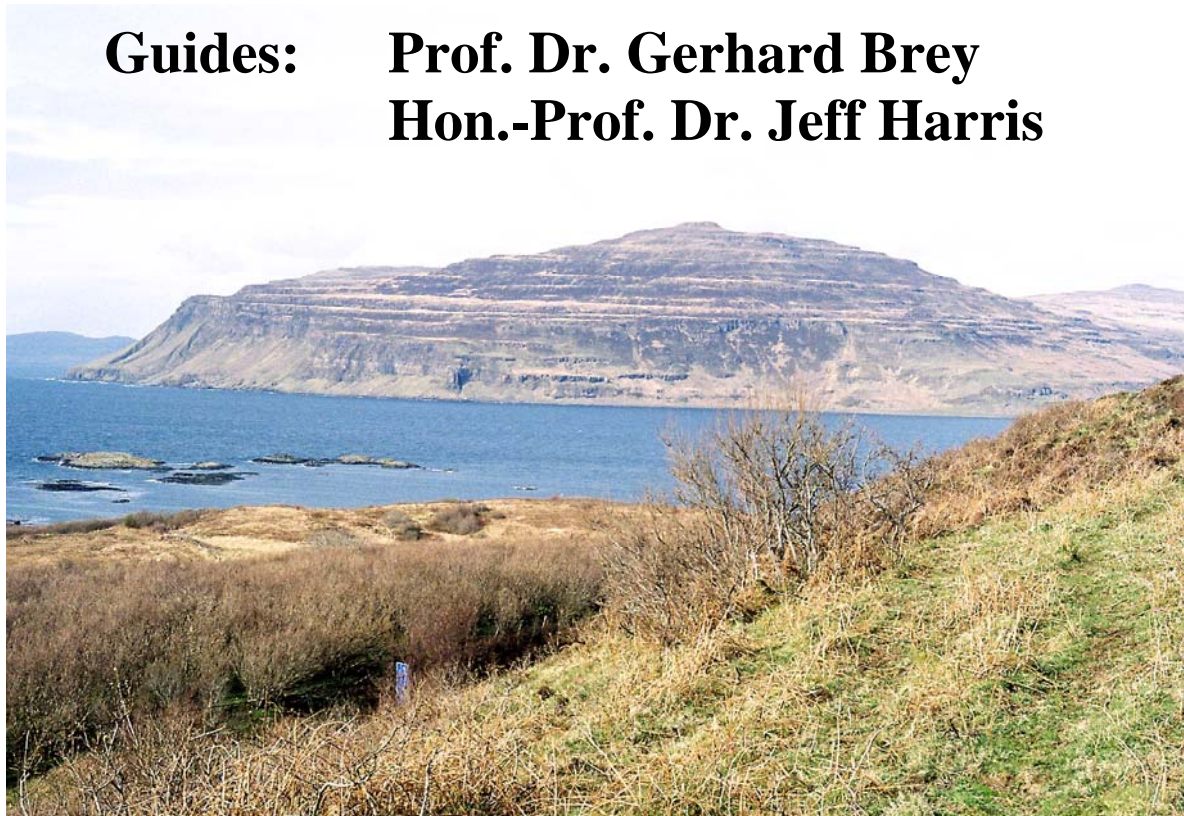
Mineralogisch-Petrologische Exkursion nach Schottland

Sunday 9th September.

Travel from Hahn to Prestwick. At present flight gets into Prestwick at about 20.00 (in the evening).

Stay over in Prestwick.

Monday 10th September.

After breakfast, travel to Oban. Collect food and beverage for 4 days. Get late or last ferry to Mull. Drive to far end of the island to Scoor House.

Tuesday 11th September.

Visit Iona and for most of the day examine the rocks in the southern part of the island, which will include a mapping exercise. If there is time, visit the world famous Abbey and religious centre. Stay at Scoor House.

Wednesday 12th September.

Consider the relationship between the Ross of Mull granite and the Moine rocks. In the afternoon, if possible, visit Staffa (£20 each). Stay at Scoor House.

Thursday 13th September.

Visit Carsaig Bay to examine Jurassic and Tertiary lava sequences. Complete a stratigraphic column.

At some stage examine in the cliff at the back of Scoor House, the relationship of an inclined sheet to the Moine.

Stay at Scoor House.

Friday 14th September.

Leave Scoor House and travel to Tobermory. Lunch and visit the distillery.

Travel to Lochaline (via the ferry). Go round a silica sand mine at Lochaline.

Then travel to the Sonachan Hotel to arrive at 19.00hrs.

Saturday 15th September.

A grand tour of the Ardnamurchan peninsula to see Tertiary igneous rocks and their relationship to the Jurassic and Moine sequences. Look at the different igneous centres. Stay at the Sonachan.

Sunday 16th September.

A mapping exercise and further inspection of the Ardnamurchan rocks. Stay at the Sonachan.

Monday 17th September.

Travel via Glen Coe and Glasgow to Prestwick for the evening flight to Hahn, which leaves about 21.00 hours.
